Show Format changes

Futurity and Derby Class and Payout Changes

- \$2,500 Added to our Open and Non Pro Futurity & Derbies.
- Int. Open and Int. Non Pro Futurity & Derbies have been eliminated.
- \$1,000 Added to the Limited Open and Limited Non Pro Futurity & Derbies.
- Schedule “B” will be used for our payouts in our Futurity and Derbies to allow for deeper payouts in all divisions of our Futurity and Derbies.

Futurity and Derby Class Rule Change

- Futurity and Derby riders may ride two handed in any NRHA legal snaffle or hackamore or one handed in any NRHA legal bit.

Paint Horse Classes

- APHA Classes will run concurrent with the AQHA classes.

Green Reiner Classes

- NRHA Green Reiner I & Green Reiner II will replace our Green Rookie class. This class will not qualify for WSRHA Year End awards but graduation awards will be offered by NRHA. Class rules and regulations will be posted soon.

Mares, Stallions and Geldings

- This class will have live bodies in the judge’s chair but will no longer be scored by a judge. Everything else will remain the same as we have done in the past.

Rug Rats Reining

- This class is for our little riders who are not in the Short Stirrup Class yet.
- This class will be offered during the lunch break at our June & October shows.

Stall Bedding

- We have contracted with Bill Amen from Denver to supply our bedding for the April and August shows. As with the other shows he does, , he will only be delivering shavings if they are pre-ordered or if you get a receipt from the show office.

Mike Craig Open Affiliate Championship Bridle

- Mike Craig has donated an elaborate show bridle that will be awarded to the Open rider who accumulates the most points at all five of our approved shows. Our Championship Series point system will be used to calculate the winner of this fine award.
