



Hello all! Our 2022 Show Season is upon us! The Show Committee is very excited about what we have planned for this year, and we want to share some important information as you begin to prepare!

INFORMATION SHARING

LOCATION! LOCATION! LOCATION!

We are again excited to be working with the great staff at the Montrose County Event Center to host our shows in Montrose, Colorado. They have informed us that the County Commissioners have placed some restrictions on the hours of operation for their facility. **The arena hours will be from 6 am to 10 pm daily for the duration of the show.** These hours should provide ample open riding for all since **our shows will start at 9 am daily.**

Schooling shows will be held in Grand Junction at the Mesa County Fairgrounds. Our first schooling show is May 7th. More detail about the format of those to come.

ADDED CLASSES! ADDED MONEY!

Our Spring Spectacular (May 25-May 29) will feature Derby Classes and \$10,000 added cash!

\$5000 added Non-Pro Derby Classes:

- Level 4 (\$2000 added)
- Level 2 (\$1000 added)
- Level 4 Novice (less than \$1500 earned) Horse (\$1000 added)
- Level 4 Four-Year-Old Redshirt (\$1000 added)

\$5000 Added Open Derby Classes:

- Level 4 (\$2000 added)
- Level 2 (\$1000 added)
- Level 4 Novice (less than \$1500 earned) Horse (\$1000 added)
- Level 4 Four-Year-Old Redshirt (\$1000)

We are also adding a “**Club Zero**” option for riders at *any level* to school in *any class*. (*EXCEPTION: Open riders may only ride in open classes.*) Eligibility restrictions are waived. Riders are not judged and will be given 4 1/2 minutes to school.

JUDGES

We will be hiring **only AAA judges** for our shows this year.

PRE-REGISTRATION PROCESS/LATE FEES

Each show will have a designated **pre- registration due date** which will be noted on the show bill as well as the website. Registering for a show can be as minimal as providing rider and horse identification information. Class entries can be done in the pre- registration process or upon arrival at the show. Class entry edits can be done during the show. This easy pre-registration process goes a long way in streamlining the work of our single show secretary in her efforts to best serve all exhibitors. **Registrations received after the due date will incur a \$25 late fee added to the show tab.**

JOIN US! AWARDS!

We expect another fun-filled show season in 2022 because..... We have an awesome membership! Please plan on completing your membership at the show in May or on the website! **Membership is a requirement for eligibility for the year end awards in each club class.** We will again be awarding saddles (Non-Pro, Limited Non-Pro, Rookie, Green), buckles, and more!
